NASRPC will maintain ongoing ranking tables for all competitors who have competed in NASRPC, or NASRPC recognised, competition.

The purpose of this is to identify our best competitors to facilitate selection for Championship Finals and for Irish Teams

Anyone who feels they should qualify, but are excluded because of the rules, may seek arbitration from the NASRPC committee, who may make an exception in their case, prior to convening a review panel to review these rules.

Ranking Scores

In order to incorporate X counts in the scores - scores in the ranking table will be recorded as

$$\text{Score} + (X \times 0.001)$$

So a score of 1489/99 would be recorded as 1489.099, whereas a score of 1489/100 would be recorded as 1489.1, giving a higher mathematical ranking.

Ranking Formula

The Ranking formula will be as follows

Sum of three highest scores, in the preceding 12 calendar months from the date of the last recognised event.

So if the last recognised match was dated 12th September 2015 - then the three highest ranking scores recorded by a competitor between 13th September 2014 and 12th September 2015, inclusive, will be added to give their ranking score.

Tie Breaks

Where a tie break situation occurs in the ranking tables - i.e. two people on equal ranking score.

Then the most recent score - the score from each person's most recent recognised event - will be used as the decider. Should those be equal, each person's next most recent score will be used and so on - until a difference is found.

This will ensure that people on equal ranking scores will be separated by their most recent performances.

Arbitration Period

Where any score is submitted at NASRPC, or NASRPC recognised, events.

Upon publication of those scores on the NASRPC website, there will be a

10 calendar day arbitration period,

where people may query the scores and correct errors.

The date and time on which arbitration ends will be published with the results.

If any corrections are made, the website will be updated, the ranking lists will be updated - however the original time and date for an end to the arbitration period will remain.

After the published date and time for an end to arbitration, no further arbitration requests will be accepted.

Qualifying individuals

Unless otherwise stated, all individuals competing in NASRPC events, or members of NASRPC clubs competing in NASRPC recognised events, will have their scores recorded in the ranking tables.

Team Selection, Championship finalists etc may have further qualifying criteria, which will be outlined in those sections.

NASRPC Events

NASRPC events are National and International Events scheduled and run by the NASRPC. The dates of these events will be published as part of the NASRPC Competition Calendar.

This includes All NASRPC National Matches, NASRPC National Championship Finals, the NASRPC Irish Open and Irish Leg of the IGRF Series.

Unless otherwise stated, all scores submitted at these events will be regarded as Ranking Scores and entered into the relevant Ranking Tables.

NASRPC Recognised Events

NASRPC may decide to recognise scores from events not run by NASRPC, for the purposes of ranking.

Unless otherwise stated, In order for scores from these events to be recognised, they must be publicly scheduled three months prior to the competition.

IGRF Events

NASRPC will recognise all scores entered at International Gallery Rifle Federation Events.

Phoenix Match

NASRPC will recognise all scores entered at the Phoenix Meeting, held, annually, by NRA UK at the Bisley Shooting Grounds in England.

German Open

NASRPC will recognise all scores entered at The German Open Action Weekend, held, annually, by the BDMP, in Leitmar, Germany.

“Other” Events

Should a competitor intend to compete in any other event, and wish for their scores to be counted towards ranking, they may make a request to the NASRPC, at least three months prior to the competition date.

The event in question must be open to all competitors.

NASRPC may decide to not include scores from such matches, if it feels that their inclusion would in any way disenfranchise any competitors within the NASRPC.

If NASRPC decides to include scores from this event then it will be published as a “Non-NASRPC Event” in the NASRPC calendar and advertised to the NASRPC, highlighting that scores will be included in the ranking tables.

Following the event, competitors must forward the official results of the competition, along with contact details for the match director, to the NASRPC Competition Director, following which, the scores will be published by the NASRPC and the Ranking Lists updated.

The normal arbitration period will apply.

In this instance, It will be the responsibility of the competitor, to inform the NASRPC Competition Director, by way of an arbitration request, of any changes to the published scores.

National Championship Qualification

NASRPC will hold National Championship Finals each year, in each of the disciplines for which Ranking tables are maintained.

The Championship Finalists will be the Top 10 competitors in the ranking table for each discipline, following the last NASRPC, or NASRPC recognised event, prior to the Championship Finals Date.

All Finalists will compete in their discipline on one day, at the location advertised by the NASRPC. Championship medals will be awarded based on scores in that Championship Final event alone.

In the event that any qualifying competitor is unable to attend, then their slot will remain vacant. Only the Top 10 may compete.

Note: Any Competitor on the same score as 10th place, discounting X count, will also qualify for the championship final. This rule does NOT apply to Benchrest Rifle Disciplines.

Irish Team Selection

Where NASRPC is entering an Irish team in an International event - the ranking tables will be used to select the team, from those who qualify to represent Ireland.

Where the qualifying team are not all able to attend, the next highest ranking substitute will be brought into the team.

Chef de Mission

The Irish squad travelling to an individual event, will have a “Chef de Mission”, who will represent the Irish squad for that event,.

This person will be the point of contact between the Irish squad and other National squads. They will liaise with the relevant National Discipline Coordinators and other NASRPC personnel..

The Selection process for Chef De Mission” will be the same as for National Discipline Coordinators.

Team Captains

Team Captain is a ceremonial position which has no function - other than to reward performance - therefore the Team Captain will be the highest ranking member of the team, on the starting day of the particular competition.

Existing team captains will have the option to complete their term - after which, the leaderboard will choose the captains, on merit alone..

Qualifying persons

Those who “qualify to represent Ireland” are:

- Anyone who holds an Irish passport (or qualifies to)
- or anyone normally resident on the Island of Ireland,
- or at least one of whose Parents were born on the Island of Ireland,
- or at least one of whose Grandparents were born on the Island of Ireland
